REVALIDATION COURSE IN OIL SPILL RESPONSE MANAGEMENT (IMO II)

The **Revalidation Course in Oil Spill Response Management (IMO II)** is designed to update and refresh the skillset of personnel who have responsibilities as functional leads in oil spill response Incident Management Teams (IMT).

The course offers practical and theoretical opportunities to review and further develop the following skills and knowledge:

- Overview of Australian response arrangements and Incident Command Systems (ICS),
- Oil Spill response initial actions, response techniques and critical areas including oiled wildlife response, waste management, media and communication, health and safety and Incident Action Planning,
- Clarifying and exercising IMT functional roles and responsibilities, and
- Review of new/revised spill response techniques and methods arising from the OGP-Joint Industry projects and other national/global groups and organisations.

Participants must have attended a certified IMO II course in the previous three years.
