

Standard Operating Procedure

Breco Bird Hazer Buoy



Equipment description

The Breco Bird Hazer is a compact, light, waterproof system used for hazing of birds within a 450mtr radius. The unit is watertight, self-righting and is designed for optimal drifting rates. The unit can be deployed in water or on land and can operate up to 96hours on a full charge

Health and Safety



All PPE to be appropriate for area of operation.

To safely operate this equipment 2 people are required. Note: The above listed Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is to be used as a guide. A life jacket may or may not be required, dependent on the deployment platform.

Safe Operating Requirements

- All personnel are to be trained in the use of the Breco Bird Hazer or under the close supervision of a trained operator
- Job Safety Analysis (JSA) to be conducted prior to work commencing. Identification of the following safety factors are critical, but not limited to:
 - o Manual Handling,
 - o Slips/Trips/Falls,
 - Vehicle/Vessel Movements,
 - o Pinch Points and Personnel
 - o Contamination/Decontamination.
 - Ensure adequate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is worn as detailed above.
 - * Life jackets must be worn on or near water depending on operation.
- A communication plan must be decided upon to ensure clear and concise communication at all times
- All incidents, accidents and near misses must be reported as per AMOSC HSSE Plan.

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Failure to follow Standard Operational Procedures may result in injury to personnel and damage to equipment



Operational instructions

Pre-start checks

- Open white hatch on upper section to place and attach battery.
- Visually inspect the Breco Bird Hazer for damage or wear.
- If applicable, ensure that all lifting equipment is in date and in good condition.

Operation

Caution Hearing protection is required when operating this equipment. **130db** sound intensity within 1 metre

- Operate push button switch on upper section to energise unit. There is a 3-minute delay after power up before initiation of audio program.
- Caution If the Breco Bird Hazer is contaminated with oil, care must be exercised when retrieving the unit to avoid causing secondary contamination. Ground sheet/Sorbent boom/bunded area should be used to mitigate this then seal and take it to a bunded cleaning station to be washed.

Post operation - Contaminated Unit

- Establish a bunded cleaning station.
- Clean the Breco Bird Hazer with hot water. If required, diesel fuel can be used to assist with the cleaning of the skimmer and accessories.
- The Breco Bird Hazer is to be dry prior to maintenance inspection, re-stowage and storage
- Ensure all equipment is returned to response ready condition.

Note - Maintenance of the unit is to be performed as listed below.

Post operation – Uncontaminated Unit

- The Breco Bird Hazer should be washed with fresh water.
- The unit is to be dry prior to maintenance inspection, re-stowage and storage
- Battery is to be removed and placed on charging rack

Note - Maintenance of the unit and accessories are to be performed as listed below.

Additional Information

Maintenance

- All maintenance and repairs are to be completed in accordance with either the manufacturer or AMOSC procedures.
- All equipment must be left in an operational condition when not in use.
- All defects must be repaired or the equipment is to be "tagged out" for maintenance and repair.
