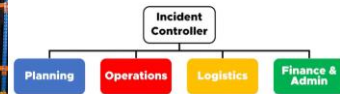

This course provides participants with the knowledge and skills to be appointed as a member of an oil spill Incident Management Team, within an Incident Control Centre.



The course is delivered in three parts;



Self paced eLearning (approx. 8-10 hrs) through our Learning Management System – modules cover the fundamentals of oil spill response and a virtual warehouse tour.



AMOSC classroom (1-day) face-to-face at AMOSC. Modules cover IMT response roles and responsibilities, supporting tools and resources and developing an Incident Action Plan.



Scenario simulations (1-day) face-to-face at AMOSC. Real-time oil spill response simulations, utilising an Oil Pollution Emergency Plan. Focuses on initial actions, gaining and maintaining situational awareness, selecting appropriate spill response strategies and supporting equipment, as well as consideration of health and safety, communications and waste management.



This course is accredited (IMO Level II Equivalent) by the Nautical Institute.
