

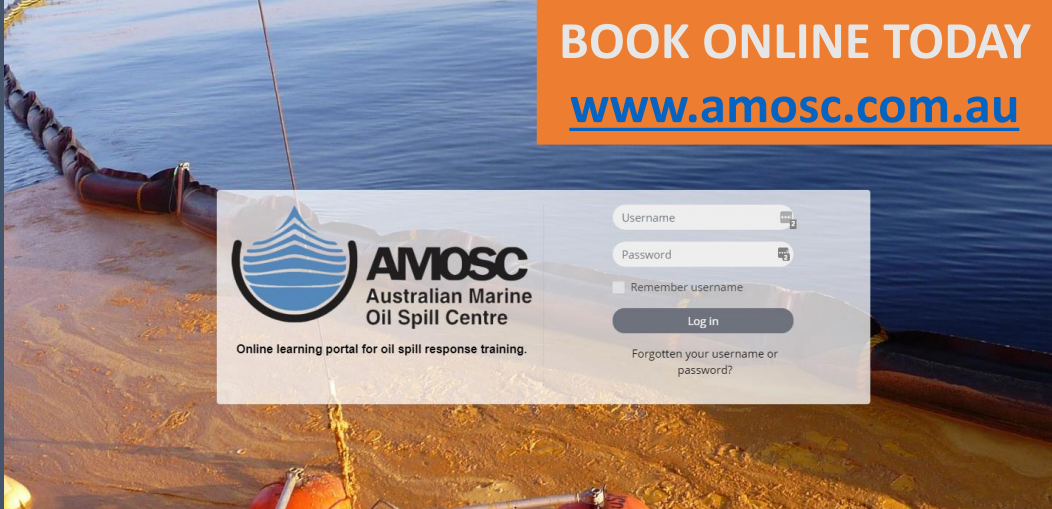

This course provides participants with the knowledge and skills required to be appointed as an Incident Controller and to effectively lead an Incident Management Team.



The course is delivered in three parts;



Self paced eLearning (approx. 8-10 hrs) through our Learning Management System – modules cover the fundamentals of oil spill response and a virtual warehouse tour.



Virtual classroom (1-day) through our Learning Management System – modules cover IMT response roles and responsibilities, leadership and decision making and Incident Action Planning.



Scenario simulations (1-day) face-to-face - real-time oil spill response simulations, utilising an Oil Pollution Emergency Plan. Incident controllers will work with an Incident Management Team (IMO II equivalent course participants), to set response objectives, select appropriate response strategies and oversee the implementation of an Incident Action Plan.



This course is accredited (IMO Level III Equivalent) by the Nautical Institute.
