Provides participants with the knowledge and skills to be appointed as members of an oil spill Incident Management Team, within an Incident Control Centre.

AMOSC classroom (1 day) face-to-face at AMOSC. Modules cover IMT response roles and responsibilities, supporting tools and resources and developing an Incident Action Plan. Scenario simulations (1 day) face-toface at AMOSC. Real-time oil spill response simulations, utilising an Oil Pollution Emergency Plan. Focuses on initial actions, gaining and maintaining situational awareness, selecting appropriate spill response strategies and supporting equipment, as well as consideration of health and safety, communications and waste management.
