Virtual Warehouse Tour



This course:

Provides participants with the knowledge and skills required to be appointed as an Incident Controller and to effectively lead an Incident Management Team.

It is delivered in three parts:



Self-paced eLearning (approx. 8-10hrs) through our Learning Management System – modules cover the fundamentals of oil spill response and a virtual warehouse tour.



AMOSC classroom (1 day) face-to-face at AMOSC. Modules cover IMT response roles and responsibilities, leadership and decision making and Incident Action Planning.



Scenario simulations (1 day) face-to-face at AMOSC. Real-time oil spill response simulations, utilising an Oil Pollution Emergency Plan. Incident controllers will work with an Incident Management Team (IMO II equivalent course participants), to set response objectives, select appropriate response strategies and oversee the implement an Incident Action Plan.
