This Course:

Is designed for **industry and agency personnel and wildlife specialists** involved in preparing for and managing wildlife activities during an oil spill response in Australia.

It is built on the Introduction to Oiled Wildlife Response course and can be completed along with the Oiled Wildlife Response Field Course.

The training will be classroom-based with trainer-led sessions, interactive group components, practical exercises and case studies. Training Sessions include:

- Equipment, resources and oiled wildlife facilities establishment
- Resources, personnel, roles and training requirements
- Documentation in an oiled wildlife response
- Management of health and safety
- Wildlife sensitivity management for oiled wildlife response
- Planning for wildlife protection
- Status of oil spill wildlife response in Australia
- Legislation relating to oiled wildlife response in Australia
