## Scenario Simulations (1 day) Face-to-Face at AMOSC

Real-time oil spill response simulations, utilising an Oil Pollution Emergency Plan. Incident controllers will work with an Incident Management Team (IMO 2 Equivalent course participants) to set response objectives, select appropriate response strategies and oversee the implementation of an Incident Action Plan.
